

Now that we are doing the Newsletters on line, there is no reason we need to include the calendar in the Newsletter. Just click the "coming events" above, the events calendar is always on the website.


Always check the website before you head out to the range, as events or weather can change things quickly.

Sheriff's Steel Plate Match - May 18



The day of Saturday May 18th was another great day at the range. We had 10 teams of 5 shooters going against the clock to see who would be the second year's winning Team Name on the Challenge Trophy. The first year's winner was the Union County Sheriffs Office Team, they placed third this year. The winning team this second year was Cherokee Guns, and second place went to the Fannin County Sheriff's Team. Each shooter, had 5 relays at the targets on the left side of the range with the slowest time tossed out. Then on the right side of the range there were 24 steel plate targets and each shooter was allowed 30 rounds to take out as many of them as they could. In most cases there were only a few left standing and for some of the shooters there were none left standing. The day also allowed for shooters to go against each other at the dueling tree. Shooters were allowed 20 rounds with a magazine change required. The one with the most swinging targets left on their opponent's side was the winner.
