Other business items included:

Ed Jones and John Case were presented achievement awards to recognize their 18 years of dedicated service as President and Vice President of the Chatuge Gun Club. During their tenure, the

club has grown from 60 to 700+ members. Verlee Jones was also recognized for her support and participation in the club.

Art Mott, Jim Vance, Nelson Fagan and Larry Mongue were approved as members of the Safety Committee.

A motion was approved to purchase a dedicated club laptop, printer and data storage devices. This dedicated equipment will be used to maintain, manage and secure the extensive electronic files and databases need to perform the club's daily operations.

Guest speakers included Union County Sheriff Mack Mason, NRA Field Representative Brad Ward and District 8 State Representative Stephen Allison. Sheriff Mason reiterated his support of the 2nd Amendment and that every Georgia citizen needs to apply for a Georgia Firearms License. NRA Rep Brad Ward discussed the importance of the NRA on not only national issues, but also issues closer to home such as providing financial aid for youth programs. Representative Allison discussed House Bill 60, also known as the Safe Carry Protection Act. He encouraged members to call in their support of the bill to the Governor's office. As you read this, Governor Nathan Deal signed HB 60 into law on April 23.

The last point of business was a drawing for a Henry Lever Action .22 Rifle. The winner was Raymond Dickey Jr.

Match Director: Larry Mongue
Set-up 8:30am, Safety Meeting 9:45,
Match starts 10am, Match finish 4 ish.

We will be having a Rimfire Rifle Benchrest
CHALLENGE match starting at 10am.
Classes are: Hunter Iron Sights (25 shots-50yds);
Hunter Scoped (25 shots-50yds);
Open Iron Sights (25 shots-50 yds);
Open Scoped (25 shots-50 yds).

Then you will shoot a "KNOW YOUR LIMITS"
targets at 100 yards for scoped and 50 yds for iron
sights (up to 5 rounds for score unlimited sighters,
10 minutes to sight & shoot for score).
Scores will be added together - high score wins.

Centerfire CHALLENGE match,
will start about 1pm with classes:
6mm & Down Scoped Rifle (25 shots-100yds)
Above 6mm up to .308 Scoped Rifle (25 shots-
100yds).

Then you will shoot a "KNOW YOUR LIMITS"
targets at 100 yards (up to 5 rounds for score
unlimited sighters, 10 minutes to sight & shoot for
score). Scores will be added together high score
wins. You can find the "know your limits" target by
doing a internet search.

Our next Cowboy Action match is scheduled for May 31, 2014. Set-up is at 8:30 A.M. Your help will be greatly appreciated. Registration will be 9:00-9:45, the safety meeting will follow registration. You must attend the safety meeting. We will shoot 4 stages, 2 stages, break for lunch then 2 last stages. This match we will have a "GREENHORN" classification for anyone that would like to try their hand at action shooting. **A safety meeting for the new shooters will be held at 9:30, you must attend!!**. Since the rules for cowboy action will be relaxed for this group, shootist points and plaques will not be awarded. You will be allowed to shoot .22 rimfire guns. Equipment required: 2 single action pistols (double action pistols allowed but must be fired single action). Rifle: lever action or pump in a pistol caliber, no bolt action or semi-auto. Shotgun: double barrel or pump action, no semi-auto. .410-12 ga. You will not need holsters, gun belts/ammo belts, All guns for this group will be staged on tables. For all, you will need 40 rounds of ammo for pistol , 40 rounds for rifle and 16+ shotgun (bring a box). I look forward to seeing everyone there. Any questions, please give me a call 706-865-1663.

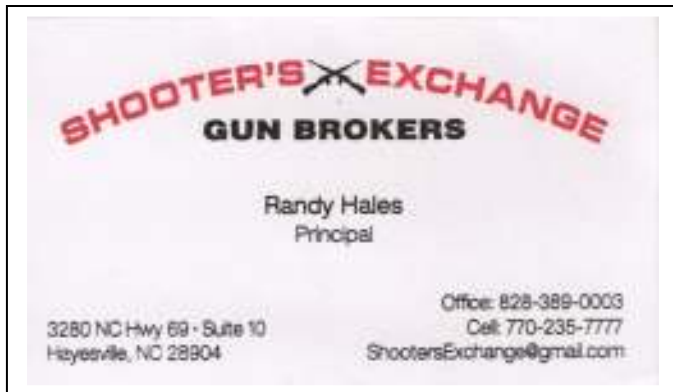
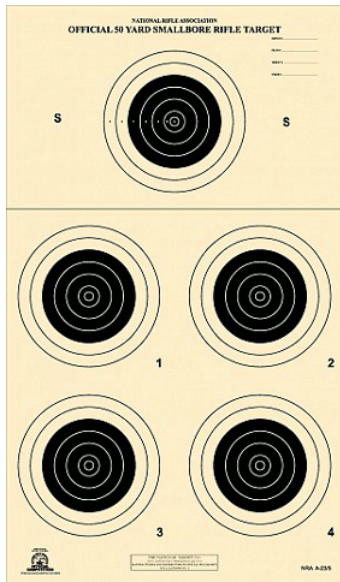

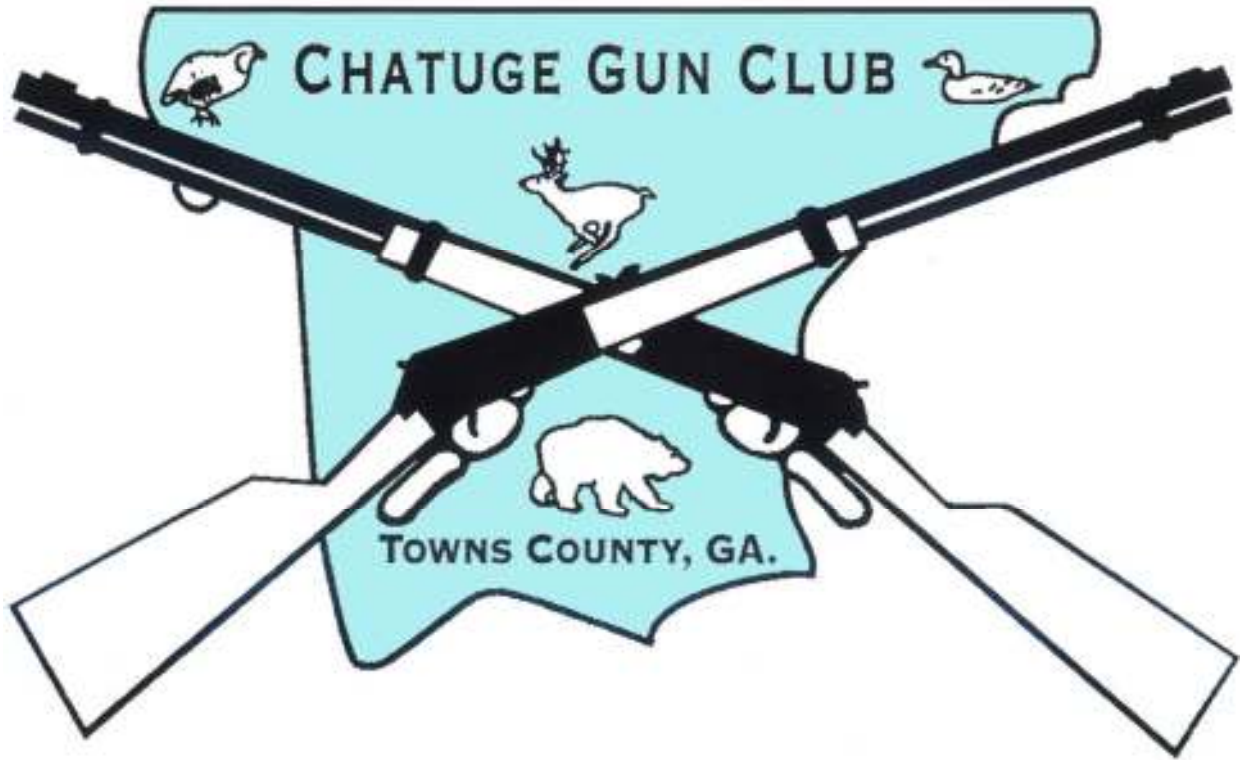
Thank you for your support and confidence and a very enjoyable and productive 18 years.
